Additional Features and Capabilities:

- **Provider Override:** Opti-Lift technologies extract data from EOBs/EOPs and match standard ANSI codes to each payer's proprietary adjustment explanatory verbiage. Adjustment crosswalking may have far-reaching accounting implications. Access EOB Conversion allows for provider-specific ANSI code preferences—overriding OrboGraph crosswalk values to better meet a provider's custom output needs.
- Interactive EOB: As data is extracted from a variety of paper and electronic sources, the system creates a Virtual EOB; a rich-text PDF with a consistent formatted template of remittance and payment data. The Virtual EOB is now activated with hyperlinking, applied to a variety of fields, enabling customer service personnel to easily see additional transaction details without manually searching.
- Access Dashboard: A new dashboard capability enables system administrates and aggregators to drill into a
 wide range of revenue sources and analyze trends. For example, EOB transactions can be analyzed by payer
 to identify specific claim and payment trends.
- EOB Indexing: Available for environments which desire access to EOB images via searchable field criteria. Clipped images are viewable in the HPAC Portal at a transaction level or claim level. Up to eight fields per claim for Full EOB Indexing.

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
